MEMORANDUM

YOUNG, D.J.

November 10, 1998

At the request of the jury, I am directed to place their unanimous observations on the record of this case:

1. While the jury is content with their verdict pursuant to the law charged, they are quite simply appalled at the vicious racial and ethnic slurs repeatedly uttered by Terence McArdle while Special Agent in Charge of the Boston office of the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, and Firearms. They do not credit his innocuous explanations of such conduct.

2. Such conduct makes a mockery of any pretense by McArdle to the even-handed enforcement of the law and renders him unfit to hold that high office.
